## EFFLORESCENCE REMOVAL FROM PAVERS - QUICK, EASY & PROFITABLE!

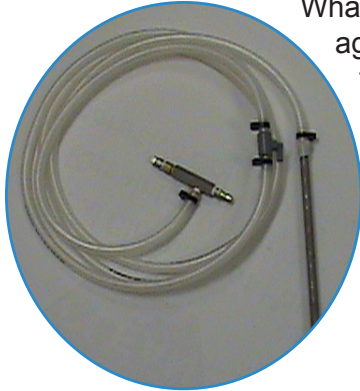

## EC Jet



What's an EC Jet? An EC Jet is a down stream injector that resists corrosion from aggressive chemicals. The EC Jet comes fully assembled and attaches to the tip of your pressure washer wand for downstream injection. The EC Jet pulls NMD 80 directly from the bucket or drum at four parts water to one part solution. When used at low pressure with the close range nozzle, over spray is dramatically minimized.

The EC Jet is still a piece of equipment and should be cleaned regularly. It is not recommended to leave the EC Jet in the bucket overnight. Replacement parts are available if needed and are easy to put on yourself.
